

PROCLAMATION NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

The Board of Elections of Madison County, Ohio issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election:
A PRIMARY ELECTION will be held on **TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2010**, at the usual places of holding elections in each and every precinct throughout the county for the purpose of choosing the following officials:

- Governor and Lieutenant Governor
- Attorney General
- Auditor of State
- Secretary of State
- Treasurer of State
- United States Senator
- Representative to Congress (15th District)
- Chief Justice of the Supreme Court
- Justice of the Supreme Court (Full Term Commencing 1/1/11)
- Justice of the Supreme Court (Full Term Commencing 1/2/11)
- Judge of the Court of Appeals (12th District) (Full Term Commencing 2/9/11)
- Judge of the Court of Appeals (12th District) (Full Term Commencing 2/10/11)
- Member of State Central Committee, Man (10th District)
- Member of State Central Committee, Woman (10th District)
- State Representative (84th District)
- Judge of the Court of Common Pleas General/Domestic Division
- County Commissioner
- County Auditor
- Member of County Central Committee

And determining the following questions and issues:

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL AND INCREASE)

JEFFERSON LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

Shall a levy renewing one million two hundred ninety-nine thousand four hundred sixty dollars (\$1,299,460) and providing an increase of one hundred fifty-two thousand eight hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$152,878) be imposed by the Jefferson Local School District, Madison County, Ohio for the purpose of **PROVIDING FOR THE EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT** in the sum of One Million Four Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$1,452,338) and levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average eight and ninety-one hundredths (8.91) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to eighty-nine and one-tenth cents (\$0.891) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2011, first due in calendar year 2012?

PROPOSED SCHOOL INCOME TAX (RENEWAL)

LONDON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Shall an annual income tax of one percent (1%) on the school district income of individuals and of estates be imposed by the London City School District to renew an income tax expiring at the end of 2010, for five (5) years, beginning January 1, 2011, for the purpose of **PROVIDING FOR CURRENT OPERATING EXPENSES** of the School District?

PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

MADISON-PLAINS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

MADISON, FAYETTE, AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES

Shall bonds be issued by the Madison-Plains Local School District **FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE LOCAL SHARE OF SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO CLASSROOM FACILITIES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** in the principal amount of \$24,950,154 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-eight years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue six and ninety-nine-hundredths (6.99) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to sixty-nine and nine-tenths cents (\$0.699) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes used in anticipation of the bonds?

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (ADDITIONAL)

MECHANICSBURG PUBLIC LIBRARY

An additional tax for the benefit of Mechanicsburg Public Library for the purpose of **CURRENT EXPENSES** at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

PROPOSED INCOME TAX

WESTFALL LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

(PICKAWAY AND MADISON COUNTIES)

Shall an annual income tax of one percent (1%) on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district be imposed by Westfall Local School District, for five (5) years, beginning January 1, 2011, for the purpose of current operating expenses?

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)
MADISON COUNTY**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Madison County for the purpose of the **OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FAIRHAVEN PROGRAMS FOR THE DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED PERSONS** at a rate not exceeding one and three-tenths (1.3) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirteen cents (\$0.13) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011. (This was formerly the Board of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities)

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (ADDITIONAL)
MADISON COUNTY**

An additional tax for the benefit of Madison County for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMUNICATIONS, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT USED DIRECTLY IN THE OPERATION OF THE MADISON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, OR THE PAYMENT OF SALARIES OF SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES** at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

**PROPOSED MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX (INCREASE)
CITY OF LONDON**

Shall the Ordinance providing for an additional one-half of one percent (1/2%) levy on income, with a credit of not more than one-half of one percent (1/2%) for residents of London who also pay municipal income tax in another municipality, for the purpose of funding the Police and Fire Departments, commencing July 10, 2010, be passed?

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (ADDITIONAL)
VILLAGE OF MIDWAY**

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Midway for the purpose of **RESURFACING THE STREETS, ROADS, AND BRIDGES** at a rate not exceeding two and one-tenth (2.1) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to twenty-one cents (\$0.21) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

**LOCAL OPTION ELECTION
MT. STERLING NORTH**

Shall the sale of spirituous liquor be permitted by Mount Sterling Post 417 American Legion, DBA Post 417 Canteen, an applicant for a D4 Club liquor permit who is engaged in the business of a war era veterans club at 27 Clark Street Mount Sterling, Ohio 43143 in this precinct?

**PROPOSED TAX LEVY (REPLACEMENT)
JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP**

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Jefferson Township for the purpose of **PROVIDING AND MAINTAINING FIRE APPARATUS, APPLIANCES, BUILDINGS, OR SITES THEREFORE, OR SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY AND MATERIALS THEREFORE, OR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF LINES OF FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH, OR THE PAYMENT OF PERMANENT, PART-TIME, OR VOLUNTEER FIREMEN TO OPERATE THE SAME, INCLUDING THE PAYMENT OF THE FIREMEN EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION AND TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**, at a rate not exceeding eleven (11) mills for each one dollar of valuation which amounts to one dollar and ten cents (\$1.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.

The polls for the Election will open at 6:30 a.m., and remain open until 7:30 p.m., on Election Day.
