

PROCLAMATION NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

The Board of Elections of Madison County, Ohio issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election:

A SPECIAL ELECTION will be held on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 3RD, 2010**, at the usual places of holding elections in each and every precinct throughout the county for the purpose of determining the following issues:

PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

MADISON-PLAINS LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

MADISON, FAYETTE, AND FRANKLIN COUNTIES

Shall bonds be issued by the Madison-Plains Local School District **FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE LOCAL SHARE OF SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO CLASSROOM FACILITIES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**, in the principal amount of \$24,950,154 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of twenty-eight (28) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue six and ninety-nine-hundredths (6.99) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to sixty-nine and nine-tenths cents (\$0.699) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2010, first due in calendar year 2011, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

The polls for the Election will open at 6:30 a.m., and remain open until 7:30 p.m., on Election Day.
